

MAMMOGRAM ASSESSMENT

Are your patients eligible for a rebate?

Diagnostic:

- Family history of breast cancer – maternal and paternal
- New lump or changing lump
- Redness
- Papilloma or phylloides (previous)
- Thickenings/ridges
- Lumpy breasts
- Dimpling/tethering
- Nipple inversion/retraction or change
- Discharge of the nipple
- Lumpectomy for malignancy
- Pain
- Skin changes

Clinical indications need to be present on the request form; otherwise there is no Medicare rebate.

Non diagnostic – No rebate/Screening:

- No family history
- No new symptoms
- Screening
- Follow up of cysts
- Fibrocystic disease
